Pesto Salmon

Basically, all you need is a six ounce portion of salmon per serving. Spread a generous tablespoon of pesto on each portion and sprinkle with shaved Parmesan or a shredded Italian cheese blend. Then grill (or bake at 375 degrees) until the salmon is cooked through (flakes easily, light pink, and firm). Serve with your favorite salad greens and side dish.
